

40 Days of Prayer



Are you ready for a 40 day prayer journey?

“For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.” Hebrews 3:4

In just a few weeks the capital campaign phase for committing resources to build a new Ministry Center on CR 99 will get fully underway.

Scripture makes it very clear that no house, or Ministry Center, or any other journey in this life should be started without seeking the Lord’s will and guidance. So, as we enter into the Building to Change Lives campaign to do a spiritual work with eternal consequences, the first thing we want to do is to reach out to God individually and collectively in prayer.

Through prayer, Jesus was able to multiply the loaves and fishes in a remarkable way. Through prayer, God can surprise all of us about the resources we can make available sacrificially to build a facility that will serve the Lord in a remarkable way in the Northwest side of Findlay and reaching out to all the surrounding areas.

Consequently, this is an introduction to a 40-day Prayer Guide. This time of prayer is twofold. First, through prayer, we want to align our own hearts with God’s heart. Second, we seek God’s will for the role we can play in the accomplishment of God’s plan.

In addition, we want to ask God’s faithful hand as we anticipate that Satan will oppose any church that seeks to advance God’s kingdom.

The next page of this Prayer Guide is an example of one way you might choose to use the guide. Taking time to meditate on the prayer suggestion for each day and the accompanying scripture will help prepare you for prayer that day.

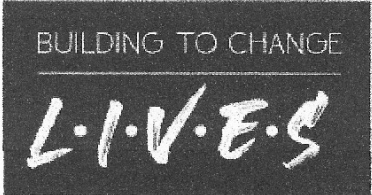

³For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance^[a]: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵and that he appeared to Cephas,^[b] and then to the Twelve. ⁶After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. ⁷Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, ⁸and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.
