

The Church at Philippi Reading Plan

Paul, Silas, and Timothy visited Philippi on their missionary adventure to Macedonia recorded in Acts 16. About 11 years later the Apostle Paul wrote a thank you back to the Philippian believers. The Bible provides an account of trials experienced by Paul & Silas on that first visit, but the extraordinary faithfulness of God as an effective New Testament church emerges from this small group of new believers.

A great way to study a short book like Philippians is to follow these simple steps:

1. Read a chapter slowly thinking about every word. (maybe even read it twice)
2. Think about what each section teaches about the character of God.
3. Ask what you should think or do in response to what you read.
4. Record what God is teaching you in the spaces below.
